## Plan Mexico: Mexico Unveils Economic Plan for Sustainable Growth

President Claudia Sheinbaum introduced one of Mexico's most ambitious economic development plans in recent years, aiming to strengthen the country's economy and global uncertainties. The plan sets bold goals, including positioning Mexico as the world's 10th largest economy, achieving 50% domestic production of consumed goods, creating 100 industrial parks, and ranking among the top five global tourist destinations. The strategy emphasizes boosting investment to over 25% of GDP, fostering specialized employment, supporting small and medium-sized enterprises, and promoting sustainable industrial practices. Analysts view the plan as a comprehensive roadmap for economic resilience, reflecting Mexico's proactive approach and commitment to economic stability and sustainable development.

## Mexico Unveils \$23.4B USD Investment Plan for CFE by 2030

Mexico announced a \$23.4 billion USD investment plan for the Federal Electricity Commission (CFE) through 2030, aiming to add 13,000 MW of capacity. The plan allows private companies to increase their role in renewable energy generation, requiring a 30% backup for reliability. Key allocations include \$7.5 billion USD for transmission infrastructure (2026-2028) and \$12.3 billion USD for expanding generation capacity. Private firms could contribute an additional 6,400-9,550 MW in renewables with investments between \$6-9 billion USD. In 2023, Mexico generated 351,695 GWh, with 76% from fossil fuels and 24% from renewables. The government emphasizes balancing renewable growth with system reliability to support sustainable energy development.

## Laredo Airport Launches New Non-stop Flight to Monterrey

The Laredo International Airport in Texas announced a new non-stop flight to Monterrey operated by Aerus. This service offers two daily flights from Monday to Friday, totaling 40 monthly flights. The 50-minute route strengthens Monterrey's role as an industrial and commercial hub in Mexico and enhances Laredo's strategic position on the U.S.-Mexico border. For 2025, Laredo Airport plans to expand routes to more Mexican destinations, aiming to boost cross-border connectivity, trade, and economic growth, while improving regional transportation infrastructure and business opportunities.

## Nearshoring Boosts Industrial Park Investment in Mexico

Mexico has seen a surge in foreign investment in industrial parks, driven by nearshoring trends. From January 2023 to November 2024, China led with approximately \$5 billion USD in investments, surpassing domestic and other international investors like the U.S. and Australia. Nearshoring accounted for 35% of industrial space demand in 2024, with 1.7 million square meters absorbed in Q3 alone.

States like Nuevo León, Baja California, Estado de Mexico, Coahuila, and Chihuahua have been major beneficiaries, especially in the automotive sector, which contributed 33-42% of new facilities. Industrial park inventory is expected to grow by 50-70% by the end of the following 6 years, reaching 150 million square meters, reflecting investor confidence in Mexico's strategic role in global supply chains.

## Monterrey to Host Latin America's Largest Electromobility Event in 2025

Monterrey will host the Global Transportation & Innovation Summit 2025, Latin America's largest electromobility event, on June 4-5 at Cintermex. The summit will gather over 500 suppliers and 100 buyers from 15+ countries, featuring global automotive leaders, academic institutions, and government representatives. The event, organized by the State's Ministry of Economy, Nuevo León 4.0, and CLAUT, aims to position the state as Latin America's Industry 4.0 hub. Major companies like Caterpillar, Kia, Ford, and Stellantis are confirmed participants.
